Meeting Minutes
21 Aug 2014

Meeting Called to Order at 7:00PM. Pledge Recited. Present: Steve Hockman, David Sies, Todd Gould, Ken Mac Connell, David Alexander, Liz Schreur, and six general members.

Meeting Minutes: July meeting minutes were reviewed. **Motion to accept the minutes made by David Alexander. Seconded and carried.**

Treasurer's Report: No report.

Executive Officers' Reports:

We are working on the rifle butts roof. Dave also brought up the idea of placemat advertising. Steve Hockman said Bay 8 has a tree that has to be taken out and there are stumps in the ground that are trip hazards.

Linwood - Ken Mac Connell said there are people still coming here and not signing-in to shoot. Ken said the gazebo is now finished and that the loaner firearms have been turned in. There were 39 students in the Hunter Education class. A woman also contacted him regarding a membership application on-line.

Unfinished Business:

- 2) **Paint Ball -** Steve Hockman had nothing new to report. Dave Alexander stated that there are companies that set up these events. Gary Cuttitta brought up the possibility of doing a fall shoot.
- 3) **LBSC Canopy -** Dave Alexander said it's done.
- 4) **Shooting Pads Grant -** Liz Schreur turned in a letter from the NRA thanking us for our application.
- 5) **Raffles -** Tonya Sies is in charge of the fundraising. Steve Hockman said he would like to have tickets for a drawing at the LBSC picnic as well as for three guns to be raffled at the annual meeting.

New Business:

- 1) **Picnic/Open House -** Steve Hockman said the date is set for September 20th, 12-4PM. He would like to see a membership drive, stuff for kids, and a raffle.
- 2) **Trap -** Jim Bourassa said shotgun is going well and that we picked up 15 new shooters last month. Jim has to give up his responsibility by September 16 and is looking for someone else to lead the program. He said most shooting is done between 4:30 and 6:00PM with smaller groups after. Steve Hockman asked to put the need in the newsletter. Jim said there is interest in starting a league again. He also has raffle

- 3) **Appreciation Dinner** - Gary Cuttitta stated that our IDPA matches and their staff have generated an average of \$5,000.00 per match. He would like to put on an LBSC appreciation dinner for those have worked the matches over the last three years, possibly include a fun shoot with it.
 - 4) **Miscellaneous** - Dave Alexander wondered when Sight-In Days were. We need to publish the dates. Steve Hockman noted that the phone number on the road sign must be changed. Gary Cuttitta said we should cover the current number. Shaun Crawford suggested we use a changeable plate. Steve Hockman wondered if the IDPA weekend match would be in conflict with the club picnic. Gary Cuttitta said we will not cancel the match.
