Meeting Minutes
18 December 2014

Meeting Called to Order at 7:00PM. Pledge Recited. Present: Steve Hockman, David Sies, Todd Gould, Tom Burzyck, Ken Mac Connell, David Alexander, Doug Young, and four general members.

Meeting Minutes: October minutes were reviewed. **Motion to accept the minutes made by David Alexander. Seconded and carried.**

Treasurer's Report: Tom Burzyck explained additional incomes and expenses on his report. His written report showed a Total Income of \$4,257.60 and a Net Income of \$-1,011.83.

Motion to accept the treasurer's report made by Larry Hayner. Seconded and carried.

President's Report: Steve Hockman thanked everyone who helped with the range lighting project.

Vice-President's Report: David Sies stated that we took in four new members in November but none in December.

Executive Officers' Reports:

Munger - No report.

Linwood - Ken Mac Connell said we need to increase our custodian's cleaning frequency. Currently it is every three weeks. Ken said he spoke to the Williams CPL class instructor about putting the club back in order. We will have to alter the soap dispensers we are using. We can't find refills for the ones we have. Ken said the 2x6's on the range need changing as does the carpet.

Unfinished Business:

- 1) **Member's Bay Lease Adjustment** - Steve Hockman said our lawyer needs a property line description around the hill. Cy Brefka wondered if we couldn't get it from the tax assessment. Dave Alexander said we will probably just have to measure it.
- 2) **Range Ventilation** - Steve Hockman said we need to talk to Mike Crawford about this.
- 3) **Liz Schreur Benefit Dinner** - Steve Hockman said he would like to nail this down in January. Scott Schindehette suggested we have a plaque made for Liz. Doug Young said that he has pictures.
- 4) **Signs and Benches at Munger** - Scott Schindehette said that he and Larry Hayner have gotten prices for materials for new benches. He wondered if we could get the Eagle Scouts to build them for us. He said we need two or three more benches. Dave Alexander recommended five or six new ones. **Motion to allot up to \$500.00 for new benches at Munger made by Steve Hockman. Seconded and carried.** Steve said he would contact the Eagle Scouts.

New Business:

- 1) **Defensive Pistol Practice** - Wednesday nights have not had anyone show up to lead or set up. We will probably have to do a sign-up again.
- 2) **Heater at Munger** - Scott Schindehette said he would like to have a heater for Sight-In Days next year. It was recommended he bring it up again next fall.
- 3) **Thermostat and Coffee Pot** - Tom Burzyck said he came into Linwood to find the thermostat set on hold and the coffee pot on with no one here. It is recommended we

change the current thermostat. Ken Mac Connell will check on a new one. Dave Alexander suggested motion sensors for the lights on the range. Larry Hayner said we should put a timer switch on the pot.

- 4) **CPL Regulations** - Doug Young wanted to know how the response to following the NRA regulations has been. The e-mail went out to all instructors regarding following NRA protocol. Doug still does not believe it is being followed. Steve Hockman wondered if we should have another CPL instructor meeting.
