Meeting Minutes  
25 June 2015

**Meeting Called to Order 7:00PM. Pledge Recited. Present:** Steve Hockman, David Sies, Todd Gould, Ken Mac Connell, Mike Crawford, Shaun Crawford, and four general members.

**Meeting Minutes:** May minutes were reviewed. Question on steel targets in front of the berm in Munger. Also a question on which bay is now designated as the Member's Bay. **Motion to accept the minutes made by Scott Schindehette. Seconded and carried.**

**Treasurer's Report:** No report.

**President's Report:** Steve Hockman said that club activity has been slow. We are in need of leadership for the various disciplines, particularly IDPA.

**Vice-President's Report:** Dave Sies also stated that things are slow, but we took in three new memberships along with renewals.

**Executive Officer's Report:**

**Linwood** - Ken Mac Connell said that he has brush-hogged and sprayed Roundup on the property. He installed a new LED outside light and sprayed for ants. He has bills from the lawn mower and the electrician and will mail them to Tom Burzyck.

**Unfinished Business:**

- 1) **Membership Drive/Picnic** - Steve Hockman said it has been cancelled due to lack of interest.
- 2) **Range Ventilation and Floor** - Mike Crawford said he would be done with the project by July 17th. Steve Hockman has talked to Josh Gentle about a new epoxy floor. Mike Crawford stated there is a lot of rotted wood in the rafters that needs replacing.
- 3) **Liz Schreur Benefit Dinner** - Still planning.
- 4) **Clays Concrete** - Jim Bourassa said the concrete work is done. The cost was \$190.00 and he placed the receipts in the safe. He said that trap is \$400.00 ahead at this time and we have been adding some new shooters. Mike Rytlewski has been helping out.
- 5) **Members Benches** - Scott Schindehette wondered about the benches that were to be built in Munger. There was a question on the amount and materials. Larry Hayner said he had the price list. They wondered if the Scouts were going to do this project. Shaun Crawford looked up the December minutes and saw that the go ahead was given to do the build for up to \$500.00. Steve Hockman urged them to do the project on their own.

**New Business:**

- 1) **Articles** - We need articles for the quarterly newsletter.
- 2) **Munger Management** - Scott Schindehette had a question about a new lock on the gate and wondered about getting some Roundup. We have some available here. Mike Crawford complained about IDPA props left on the range from the Regional. He had to move the poker table out of Bay 1. Steve Hockman stated that the Munger range is looking scruffy -- tree branches in the road, etc. Larry Hayner said the branches have been moved.
- 3) **3-Gun Cancelled** - Mike Crawford said that 3-Gun is cancelled for July due to the holiday. He said there were 36 shooters at the June match and a pro shooter

from out of the area also participated. Our name is getting around, but we still need more help.

- 4) **Miscellaneous** - There was concern about Bay 9 safety. Talk of building the berm behind the shed and/or repairing the wall. Discussion about having traffic go to the left in front of the 100 yard line and using signs and barriers. At Linwood we are getting complaints about jackets ricocheting back at shooters. Discussion about oiling the backstop like they used to do. Ray Gentle has oil available if we decide to do it.
