

Linwood-Bay Sportsman's Club
Meeting Minutes
16 June 2016

Meeting Called to Order at 7:00PM. Pledge Recited. Present: Tonya Sies, Doug Young, Todd Gould, Tom Burzyck, Ken Mac Connell, Mike Rytlewski, and eight general members.

Meeting Minutes: The May minutes were reviewed. **Motion to accept the minutes made by Ted Beauchamp. Seconded and carried.**

Treasurer's Report: Tom Burzyck gave his May report and pointed out the Great Lakes Regional income. He also noted the sale of the Munger lawn mower and membership dues. Tom's written report showed a Gross Income of \$26,402.00 with a Net Income of \$12, 226.68. When asked about the profit of the Regional, Tom stated it to be roughly \$10,000.00. **Motion to accept the treasurer's report made by Doug Young. Seconded and carried.**

President's Report: Tonya Sies said she still wants to get the signs up at Munger and hopes to get information from Lisa Valentine regarding fundraising.

Vice-President's Report: Doug Young stated we had four new memberships in May.

Executive Officers' Reports:

Munger - Mike Rylewski has purchased Roundup and a sprayer. He repaired the shed doors and installed a plastic chain at the 300 yard line to prevent ATVs from running through during shoots. He will also install a chain at the 100 yard line and plans to hang signs on them. He spoke to Duane Ackerman about the installation of a flag pole. There was a question about the lawn mower's ability to pull a roller.

Linwood - Ken Mac Connell said he drained the air compressors. There was discussion about the wall timers. He said the Bunn coffee maker must remain unplugged when not in use. Tonya Sies said she would put a sign on it, but Doug Young recommended we just store it. We have new roofing rubber coming for the backstop. We also need a new DVD player. Doug said he would pick one up.

Unfinished Business:

- 1. Munger Berms** - Doug Young said nothing has been done. It is in the hands of the range committee. There was discussion on the possible use of the existing RR ties.
- 2. Water Fowlers for Warriors** - Doug Young spoke to Zach Fowler about a trap shoot before the duck hunt. A date is yet to be determined.

New Business:

- 1. Steel Targets for 3-Gun** - Doug Young stated that 3-Gun Nation classifiers are what bring shooters in. He would like to run two or three at a time but needs steel targets. He has a price of \$1610.00 for the steel he wants. There was a question on where it would be stored. He will price other fabricators as well. **Motion made by Doug Young to spend up to \$1800.00, including tax, on steel targets. Seconded and carried.**
- 2. Loan of Drop-Turns** - Scott Rifenbark wants to borrow our drop-turn targets for the Shop With a Hero benefit shoot. **Motion to loan the targets made by Doug Young. Seconded and carried.**
- 3. 3-Gun Shotgun Classifier** - Doug Young would like to have a shotgun classifier in the evening under the lights on the clays range. He needs to check with Frazier township about a noise curfew.
- 4. New Directors** - Tonya Sies reviewed Article XII, Section 2 of the LBSC By-Laws

regarding board members who have missed three consecutive meetings. Tim Reed and D.J. Beebe were appointed to replace the two who have been absent (Tim - a one year term, and D.J - a two year term).

5. **Clays** - Jim Bourassa said trap shooting has been going better than last year. We will need to purchase more targets at \$617.40 per skid. **Motion to purchase two skids of clay targets made by Ted Beauchamp. Seconded and carried.**
6. **Target Shelter** - Ted Beauchamp would like to put a target shelter in Bay One to store targets for members and protect props. D.J. brought up the idea of a lean-to off the back of the current target shed. Tonya Sies would like to speak with all parties regarding their ideas.
7. **Miscellaneous** - Scott Schindehette would like a volunteer from IDPA or 3-Gun to mow the grass while he is away. Mike Rytlewski had a question regarding the pistol bay. Posting hours was suggested. Tonya Sies is working on signage. Tom Burzyck will be gone for July and August.

Motion to adjourn made by Tom Burzyck at 8:15PM. Seconded and carried.
