The league has turned in \$3212.00 this year, \$1200.00 above this time last year. Tonya Sies wondered if we could help the teen shooting club from Reese on Tuesdays. Jim said we could use the second machine, but another night would be better.

Tonya Sies confirmed the job description from the club By-Laws. We have new first aid kits with clotting sponges. It was decided we should have more clotting sponges.
