Meeting Minutes
21 October 2016

Meeting Called to Order at 7:00PM. Pledge Recited. Present: Tonya Sies, Doug Young, Todd Gould, Tom Burzyck, Ken Mac Connell, Steve Hockman, D.J. Beebe, Tim Reed, and two general members.

Executive Officers' Reports:

Munger - Tonya Sies said that the weed Round-Up on the range never got done. Mike Rytlewski is currently in Florida.

Linwood - Ken Mac Connell said he replaced several flood lights. He believes we should put the form for the ladies class registration on-line. We have had a problem with the gate not working (now is). Ken bought a new coffee maker with a timer. There was a question about an odor in the building.
