3 Gun Nation Club Series

On June 7th the 3 Gun Nation Club Series was back in action at the LBSC Munger facility where 37 shooters tried to tame 5 stages. Amongst local, and shooters from all over Michigan, the match was also challenged by 2 shooters from Canada, 1 shooter from Florida, 1 Shooter from North Carolina, and 1 shooter from Alaska. All shooters commented on what a great and challenging match LBSC once again put on.

The Factory Division was topped by Eric Lichtenberg, with a final time of 317.89 followed by Jeff Johnson with 395.80

Heavy Optics was dominated by Walt Moeller with a final time of 546.88 with only 45 seconds in total Penalty time.

Lynn Tracey ran away with the rim fire division with a total time of 802.21.

Mike Crawford squeaked out a win over D.J. Beebe in the Optics PCR division with a final time of 547.36 topping D.J.'s time of 619.88

On to the Practical Division where 20 shooters were registered and it was a close one. at the top with John Sprietzer with a final time of 196.62 barely edging out Frank Garcia who posted a 197.13 final time.

The Unlimited division also displayed a close match as Don Baldwin and Brad Rainey went head to head all day in a match that in the end put Brad Rainey at the top spot with a final time of 295.66 and Don Baldwin ending up with a 305.20

The July Match was not held due to Independence day weekend Holiday, but 3 Gun nation will be back again on August 3rd And Sept. 6th for another round of challenging stages.

open to members. The Members bay is,
Bay 9 which is the first bay to the right of the hill.
Firearms allowed are; pistols, rifles, & shotguns with
birdshot only. NO RIFLES CAN BE USED TO SHOOT
THE PLATE RACK.. NO EXCEPTIONS! Again, The steel
plate rack in the member's bay can be used with
Pistols and birdshot shotgun only. This Bay and its
equipment must be taken care of. Clean up all brass,
shotgun shells, and trash. Rifle shooters and pistol
shooters in Bay 9 please communicate with each other
so your range time can be safe. Enjoy your new
member's bay and again, keep it clean, put stuff
away, and again, NO RIFLES USED ON THE PLATE
RACK.**

Munger range

If the lock for the main gate is missing it's
because the property owner has it, and he's using
that entrance to come in and out with his front
end loader. Just close the gate behind you when
you leave. Also when shooting from the 100 yd.
marker, or further please put the cones and
caution tape across the road at that 100 yd. spot.
When you're done remove the cones. It will alert
anyone who is driving through that part of the
range near the 100 yd. benches. Again police
your brass and trash on the rifle range. The rifle
range looks great (great job Scott Schindehette)
let's keep it looking great.
