

## Munger Range Rules

Shooting Hours—9 am to 9 pm or sunset, whichever comes first Restricted  
Hours on Sunday for 200 and 300 yard range—12pm to 5pm

### Gun Safety

1. Always keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction
2. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
3. Always keep the firearm unloaded until ready to use
4. Always be sure of your target and what is behind it

### Safety Rules

1. All un-holstered firearms are to have actions open or have it flagged
2. No mishandling of firearms allowed at any time-anywhere
3. Do not load your firearm until you are in the shooting station and it is your turn to shoot
4. Any disturbance or misconduct (horseplay) will not be tolerated
5. No shooter will shoot at another person's target
6. No alcoholic beverages or drugs allowed
7. Eye and ear protection must be properly used
8. Practice good sportsmanship
9. Cleanup after each use. Take home what you brought, such as brass and targets.
10. Keep all muzzles pointed downrange. Be considerate of the houses nearby.
11. All steel targets must be shot no closer than 10 yards
12. Member Ranges are on a first come, first serve basis. Under no circumstance shall anyone use the Rifle Range while the Member's Bay is in use. Please wait your turn and communicate with other shooters. During sanctioned events, the event will take precedence for range use during the allotted time. During days that the range is open to members, please be mindful and considerate of other members. Please limit yourself to one hour if other shooters are waiting.

### STICTLY PROHIBITED

1. Shooting into the front of the protection hill of the rifle butts is not permitted under general range use
2. Do not shoot at the trees – please use target stands to hold your targets
3. Range props sitting behind the shed by bay 10 are not for general membership use, only for events
4. Exploding targets are not permitted under general range use

### Bays available for use by membership

1. Rifle—Bay 10 from 50, 100, 200\*, and 300\* yard ranges, targets are available from target butts
  - a. Under no circumstance shall anyone use the rifle range while the pistol bay is in use. It is your responsibility to ensure no one is ahead of the firing line. Please ensure the Members Bay is empty before uncasing firearms.
  - b. When shooting from behind the drive (100, 200 and 300 yards), make sure to put the chain across so nobody drives around while you are shooting. Make sure to remove the chain when done.
2. Handgun—Bay 9—shooting of the steel is allowed, wood target stands and sticks at bay 9 can be used by membership.
  - a. Place the “Pistol Bay In Use, Rifle Range Closed” Road Cone at the Tractor Shed **on** the North/South drive.
  - b. Move “Pistol Bay In Use, Rifle Range Closed” Road Cone to the North side of the tractor shed upon leaving.
  - c. Under **No Circumstance** shall anyone use the rifle range while the members bay (Bay 9) is in use.
  - d. Steel Plat Rack in Member's Bay (Bay 9) is for **Handgun Caliber** use only.
3. EVENT USE ONLY—Bays 1–8 are only for use during club events. Please respect private property and do not use.

### Suggested supplies to bring with you

- Targets
- Stapler
- Masking tape/pasters

If you are caught violating any of these rules, membership will be suspended until the next board meeting. If suspended, member is required to attend the board meeting before membership can be considered for reinstatement.
